Important Information relating to camp policies

Bunk 1: A creative way of sending your campers a message. Through this service, you will be able to send one-way e-mail messages to your child at camp. You may include pictures, graphics, puzzles, etc. in your messages. Be sure to pick up an information brochure at registration.

Your child may qualify for two different age groups: Edinboro Camp allows campers who have had a birthday within six months of the start of camp to move backward. Campers who will have a birthday within the coming six months can move forward. (For example, a camper who is 9 but will be turning 10 in September can go to the 8 & 9 camp week or opt to attend the 10 & 11 camp week). HOWEVER, campers MUST have celebrated their 15th birthday in order to attend Teen Week, and must be age 6 to attend Explorer Camp Weekend.

Homesickness/Visiting Campers/Phone Calls: Homesickness is always an issue, but we have found that campers deal with homesickness much better if they don't see their parents or someone else's parents. So we do not encourage visitation during the week. If you feel it is to the camper's benefit that you should visit, or call them, then please call the Executive Director (Pastor Blair Blakeslee) 814-882-9816 and make arrangements. Thank you!
