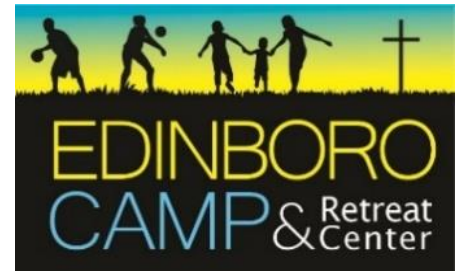


# January Praise and Prayer Newsletter
