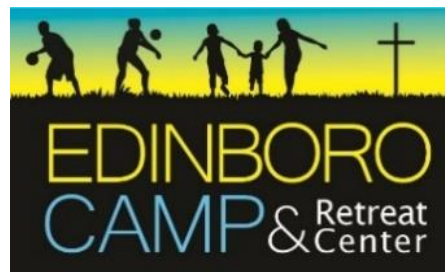


November Praise and Prayer Newsletter
