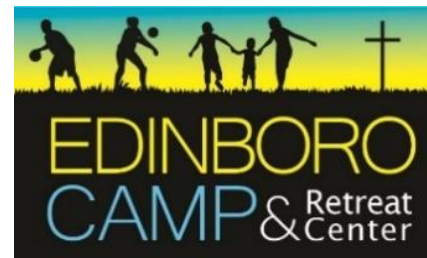


March Praise and Prayer Newsletter
