****Please leave all cell phones at home****

- 3 pants
- 1 sweatpant
- 6 shorts
- 8 tops
- 2 swim – 1pc
- 4 bras
- 5 socks
- 8 underwear
- 1 long sleeve
- 1 hoodie
- 3 pj's – (1) pant/shirt style (2) shorts/shirt style
- 1 light jacket
- Raincoat
- Umbrella
- Rain boots
- Tennis shoes
- Crocs
- Flip flops
- Bible
- Notebook
- Pen for note taking
- Bed side fan – dorms get stuffy at night
- Night light
- Hamper or laundry basket – dirty clothes
- 6 clothes hangers – to hang coats, wet clothes or towel on to dry
- 4 bath towels
- Money for snack shop (\$20-25) if you didn't do it online
- 2 beach towels
- Name marked on it Water bottle
- Flashlight
- Trashcan/Walmart bags
- Pillow
- Sleeping bag or blanket/comforter
- Twin sheet
- Special sleeping stuff (stuffed animal, blankets etc)
- Caddy to carry shower stuff to shower (we use a drawstring bag)
- Shampoo
- Conditioner
- Soap/body wash
- Washcloths(2) or loofah
- Tooth brush
- Toothpaste
- Hair brush
- Hair ties, headbands etc
- Deodorant
- * Feminine products
- Sunscreen – put name on it
- Any prescription medicines?
- Goggles – mark name on it
- Bug spray
- Hat
- Sunglasses

We pack our kids' stuff in a 3 drawer plastic steralite dresser – its easier for our kids to keep their stuff organized... lots of people use suitcases, tote bags,etc. just whatever is best for you guys.
