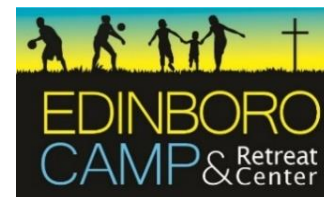


January Praise and Prayer Newsletter
